Policies Regarding Travel & Surgeries - Please Read Before Signing

MISSION STATEMENT:

Face the Challenge (FTC) exists to show the compassion of Christ by providing medical care primarily for children, but also for adults, in developing countries. By using gifts of mercy and the latest skills in medicine, FTC desires to improve the lives of all with whom it comes in contact.

As mentioned in the FTC Risk and Release of Liability Form, inherent risks to FTC surgical team members exist. It is recommended that each team member indicates, by signing this Policies Form that he/she has adequate provision for life insurance, a current will, and other vital documents accessible to a designated contact. Following is a list of Travel Policies to which the undersigned Applicant agrees to comply during the entire time he/she is affiliated with the FTC Surgical Team:

- 1. As a selected FTC surgical team member, I will behave in a manner representative of FTC that is professional, kind, and prudent.
- 2. I will respectfully comply with governmental, cultural, and moral standards of the regions to where the FTC teams go.
- 3. For safety reasons, I understand that I need to remain with the team when traveling or on public outings.
- 4. I understand that I am to inform team members of my plans and whereabouts at all times.

- 5. I recognize that the FTC team will have a daily contingency plan for communication, transportation, and leadership and that my flexibility and positive attitude will help. If I am unclear of any plans, I will ask.
- 6. I recognize that FTC is a Christian organization and that prayer and devotions will be a part of the trip, as time permits and situations allow. My attendance is welcomed, but not required, except where organizational meetings are included.
- 7. While the FTC Board prefers that all surgical team members abstain from consuming any alcohol at all during the trip, I will limit my consumption to two drinks at dinner. Further, I will not possess or use illegal substances.
- 8. I will avoid all conduct during the trip that would have the appearance of impropriety.
- 9. I agree to help with the pre-surgical screenings, and if designated, I will take clinical photographs, slides, and/or videos to assist in this process. I acknowledge these items will be the property of FTC and copies will be available to me at my own expense.
- 10. I will provide documentation for the surgical records, kept in the possession of FTC. If I am a surgeon, I will submit dictated operative reports, due at the end of the trip. I understand that FTC agrees, in turn, to send me copies of my reports in a timely manner after the trip's termination.
- 11. If evacuation is necessary, I acknowledge that FTC has a standard team evacuation plan and I am willing to comply with its requirements.
